Hints and Tips

- You could put a collection tin in your reception area or staff room to help collect donations.
- Be safe remember to check Health and Safety policies.

Keeping it legal

If you are planning a raffle for us, you will need to be aware of the following licensing regulations. You do not need a licence to organise an incidental non-commercial raffle, i.e. those where:

- tickets are purchased and drawn at the event and there are no cash prizes
- prizes cost no more than £500 to purchase.
- Any raffle falling outside of these guidelines will require a licence.
